- For Decorative Accent Rugs Unroll the flooring in the room and allow it to relax. Material must be lying flat before fitting.
- Cut flooring to the desired rug or mat size and enjoy your new rug!

For Permanent or Glueless Installation Over Existing Resilient Flooring

- Unroll the flooring in the room and allow it to relax. Material must be lying flat before fitting.
- Maintain room temperature, flooring and adhesive between 65° F and 85° F for 48 hours before, during and after installation. .
- Leave a 1/4" space between flooring and all verticals (i.e. walls, cabinets, pipes, etc.). When trimming floor, place a small piece of 1/4" plywood between the wall and back of flooring to insure proper gap is achieved.
- Install wood moldings or cove base around the perimeter to cover the 1/4" space. Do not nail mouldings through the flooring nail into the wall.
- Maintain post-installation room temperature between 55° F and 100° F with a relative humidity between 40% and 70%.

- Can be fully adhered with Tarkett QBond-One adhesive. Refer to the Tarkett website for full installation instructions.

Basic Care

- Repeated exposure to direct sunlight may cause fading or discoloration. Close drapes or blinds to block direct sunlight during peak hours.
- If your rug gets wet, be sure to dry under the mat to prevent mildew growth.
- High heeled shoes can cause permanent damage to many types of resilient flooring, including tile and plank.
- Moving furniture and appliances may cause scratches or indentations in your new floor. Make sure furniture and appliances are equipped with proper, non-staining rests, glides or casters.
- Use proper rests, glides and casters on furniture. Small, narrow furniture rests should be replaced with wider, smooth, non-staining, protective, load-bearing devices (at least 1" square bearing surface).
